

# Do the approval workflow states assigned to diagram in Process Manager disappear, if I delete them from the setup?

Problem:

I defined some different diagram states in Process Manager and have been using them in Workflow Accelerator. What happens if I delete them from the setup ("Setup" > "Manage approval workflows" > "Diagram states")?

Solution:

If you delete a diagram state in "Manage approval workflows", the states already assigned to the processes will be still present in the diagram overview. The status icon will disappear when you save a new revision of a diagram.

Please note:

The diagram states (which were previously deleted from "Manage approval workflows") will be still assigned to the diagrams in Process Manager, until you remove them from corresponding Workflow processes.

During the approval workflow, different states can be assigned to the revision of a diagram. An icon next to the diagram represents its state. You can either use the diagram states defined by Signavio or create your own list of diagram states. The "Publish in Hub" option specifies that a revision will be published automatically in the Collaboration Hub if this state is assigned to the revision. The "Reset expiration" option specifies that the approval expiration date will be (re-)calculated from when this state is assigned.
